| 2 months | Exam, Pediarix #1, Hib #1, PCV13 #1, oral rotavirus #1 |
| 4 months | Exam, Pentacel* #2, PCV13 #2, oral rotavirus #2 <i>We will substitute Pentacel for Pediarix if possible, so your child can get one fewer injection.</i> |
| 6 months | Exam, Pediarix #3, Hib #3, PCV13 #3, oral rotavirus #3, Hgb (Iron), Lead Risk Screen. |
| | Influenza vaccine is recommended each winter for everyone over months of age. |
| 9 months | Exam |
| 12 months | Exam, PCV13 #4, Hep A #1, Hgb (Iron), TB Risk Screen |
| 15 months | Exam, MMR#1, Varicella #1 <i>Because of the change from PCV7 to PCV13, many children 15 mos-4 years of age will also need a single dose of PCV13 to catch up</i> |
| 18 months | Exam, DTaP #4, HIB #4 |
| 2 years | Exam, Hep A #2, Hgb (Iron), TB Risk Screen, BP, Lead Risk Screen, Vision Screen |
| 2 ½ years | Exam |
| 3 years | Exam, Hgb (Iron), TB Risk Screen, Urine, BP, Vision Screen |
| 4 years | Exam, Kinrix, MMR #2, Varivax #2, Hgb (Iron), TB Risk Screen, Urine, BP, Vision and Hearing Screens |
| 5 years | Exam, Hgb (Iron), Hearing and Vision Screens, TB Risk Screen, Urine, BP |
| 6, 7 years | Exam, Hgb (Iron), TB Risk Screen, Urine, BP, Vision Screen (every other year if not done at school) |
| After age 7 | Exam recommended every 1-2 years. Tdap Booster and meningitis vaccine are given at 11 or 12 years. For girls, a vaccination for cervical cancer is recommended in three doses starting at age 11. |

Legend: Pediarix = combo vaccine IPV + DTaP + Hep B; PCV13 = pneumococcal conjugative vaccine; Pentacel = combo vaccine IPV + DTaP + HIB; Kinrix = combo IPV + DTaP.
